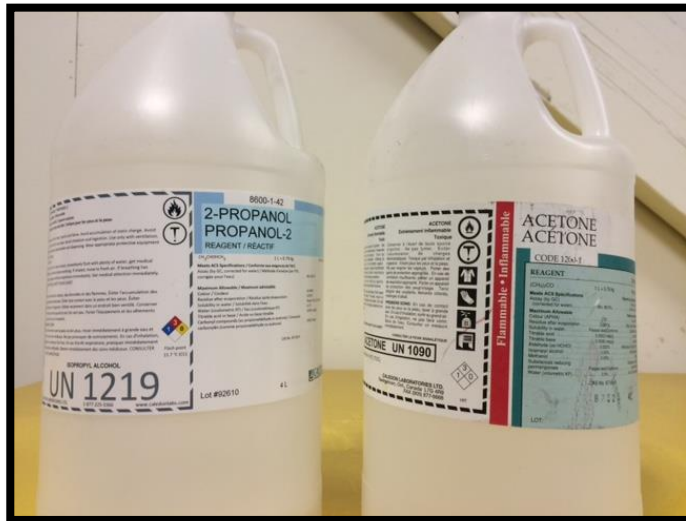

When is Secondary Labeling Needed

All chemicals come properly labeled from the manufacturer.



Once the chemical is placed in a second container it needs secondary labeling placed on the container.

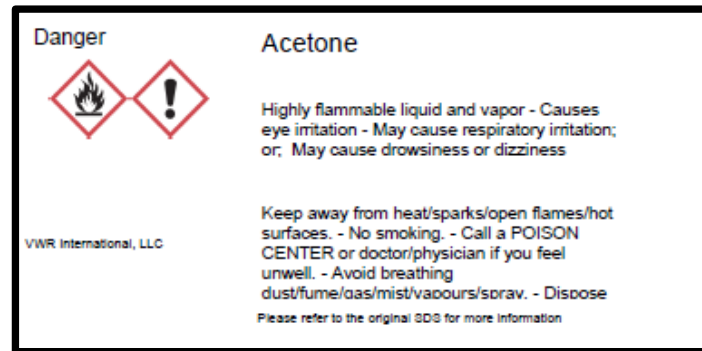

Chemical Labels

All chemicals need to have Globally Harmonized System (GHS) compliant labels. The label allows you to know exactly what you are working with.



Example of a GHS compliant label

Smelling or sniffing a chemical is not a proper way to identify a chemical.

➤ Pre-Labelled Bottles

Pre-labeled bottles while convenient do not meet the GHS label standard. Please print a label for the bottles.
