Subject: 10/3-10/7 Pipe repair and 10/10-10/14 Hydrostatic test of RW-21 pipeline.

Northrop Grumman is providing this progress report to you on our activities in support of the RW-21 groundwater treatment system project and other associated environmental activities.

Pipe Repair:

From Monday, October 3 through Friday, October 7, our contractors will conduct repairs on an influent pipe section located in the southern corner of Municipal Lot A off Seaman Avenue. They will excavate from the RW-21 vault to the area to be repaired within the work zone shown below. Soil removed from the excavation will be temporarily lain aside and returned to the excavation when the work is complete. Following completion of the repair, the excavation will be backfilled, and the asphalt restored.

In preparation, the following work zones will be set up on Sunday, October 2, as outlined in the photo below. The work zone is delineated in red. To allow vehicles to traverse fully within the lot, the area in yellow will be used as a travel corridor in lieu of parking. Work will take place between 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.



Hydrostatic Pipeline Testing:

From Monday, October 10 to Friday, October 14, a hydrostatic test will be conducted near the north end of S. Sheridan Avenue. One crew stationed on S. Sheridan Avenue (near Central Avenue) will fill the pipeline with clean water from a hydrant while a second crew drives the length of the pipeline to inspect. This work will not require lane or road closures, nor will it block any driveways.

We are continuing our routine groundwater sampling and groundwater level measuring program at various locations through the month of September. Residents near our work zones receive specific notices in advance of our work on their street.
